Weathering Paints:

- mwe-017 burnt metal
- mwe-009 dark rust
- mwe-010 medium rust
- mwe-011 light rust

Pigment:

mwp-007 soot black

Wash:

• mwe-008 earthy grime

How to #2

How to:



- 1. Using an airbrush, paint the entire exhaust with Burnt Metal paint. Operate at a pressure of about 1.5 bar. Apply multiple thin coats for full coverage.
- 2. Rinse the airbrush with clean water and change the color to Dark Rust. Paint with a transparent layer from almost the end to the end of the exhaust, giving only a tarnish.
- 3. Change the color to Medium Rust and paint as above, but only closer to the center about half the total exhaust length.
- 4. Change the color to light rust and paint the very center. Apply multiple coats until you get the desired effect.
- 5. Use Soot pigment to dust the tip of the exhaust. Done!
